

NIS PROFICIENCY to become an Academy 1 Member

To Maintain ACTIVE Academy 1 Membership

- 1.) Stay up to date
Seminar Attendance - Members need to complete a MINIMUM of 1 of the following seminars every SECOND year; Module A, Module B or Masters.
On- line Training - Members are required to participate in ALL Academy on-line training of research updates they have missed.
- 2.) Academy Subscription Fee - Due on an annual basis.

Who can sit Proficiency?

Practitioners must have completed a minimum of 2x Module A and 2x Module B seminars in the last 4 years. (i.e. 2006 - 2009) *NB- NIS seminar attendees from 2006-2008 only need to complete 1x Module A & 1x Module B.*

Registrations must be received no later than **4 weeks prior** to the assessment date.

Official assessment results will be notified by mail or email within 4 weeks of assessment date. If you do not pass you will have the opportunity to re-sit by re-registering. A registration fee will apply.

Study Suggestions

What you need to know

NIS System

Knowledge of the current NIS system (Modules A & B from 2009 will be assessed).

Candidates will be supplied with a list of the current Module A & B protocols in order to use as a memory jogger in the exam. (please note this is not the screen test chart.)

Please know the screen and correction for each of the following protocols:

fungal/ bacterial/ protozoa/ virus / tensegrity/ joint proprioceptors/ connective tissue / cerebellum integration/ glands engine/ neurotransmitters/ antigens

Anatomy & Physiology

Knowledge of the location and anatomical contact points for all glands, primary muscles, cortical centres and the 7 NIS 'engines' of the brain. Study & know the organ/gland relationship chart.

Also Muscle testing (what it is and how we use it with NIS)

The basic principles of the NIS system

Assessment Format

- Candidates are given a 10-15 minute (approx) practical assessment.
- Candidates will be asked to begin running the NIS system as they would in practice, they will not however be asked to run the whole system in its entirety.
- Candidates will be asked to demonstrate the correct procedure of selected Module A & B protocols (see the list above). Please note - not all protocols in the list will be assessed on the day.
- Candidates will be asked oral questions to demonstrate their understanding of the basic NIS principles.

Candidates will be provided with a list of the current Module A & B protocols. They may not take anything else into the exam.

Please be there 5 minutes prior & allow up to 20 minutes to complete the full assessment.

Who does the assessment?

Assessments are done by NIS Academy 3 Trainers in conjunction with NIS seminars.
